Lewey Lake has an Outlet connecting it to Indian Lake, one of the larger Adirondack lakes. The campground features hot showers, a sand beach & swimming area, bathhouse, Hiking Trails and Boat launches on both Indian and Lewey Lakes. Check in Time is 11 AM.
