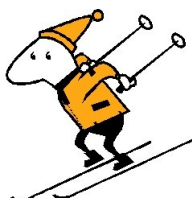


Sunday River Ski Trip 2013 February 3rd-9th, 2013

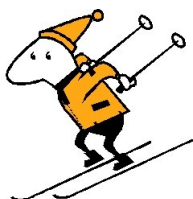
